- Packages will be delivered to residences during the holidays. Need to be home to receive packages or ask a trusted neighbor to look out for deliveries to prevent theft.
 - Be aware of suspicious people in your neighborhood. Please contact the police if you see suspicious activity.
- Other ways to prevent theft during the holidays...
 - Don't carry large amounts of cash.
 - Be aware of your surroundings when using your pin number.
 - Don't keep packages in your car. Thieves can easily break a window to get packages that are in full view inside a car.
 - Leave lights on when you are away and keep outside lights on to deter break-ins.
 - CPTED – Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design
 - Officers trained in CPTED will perform on-site reviews of property and make suggestions on how to deter criminal activity and create a safe environment.
- Colder weather is coming for fall and winter. Be careful driving and be aware of road conditions.
 - If you are in an accident pull off to the side of the road to exchange information.
 - Accident reports must be filed by all parties involved if there is \$1,500.00 in vehicle damage, if a vehicle is towed from the scene or if there are any injuries.
 - Call the police in the case of a hit and run or if there are injuries or if you feel you need assistance.

- Lot located near Morgan/Hackamore could possibly be improved to provide public area. Possibly provide walking path, benches, ball court, etc. – Possible agenda item for next month.
