Art On Broadway – January Events

Member artists of Art On Broadway Gallery in Beaverton show off their talents with their "Winter Group Show" now through January 28, 2012. Featuring fine art from award-winning local artists working in a variety of traditional and contemporary media the exhibit includes original works in watercolor, oil, pastel, acrylic, glass, ceramic, found metal sculpture, and hand-crafted jewelry.

Beaverton resident and Art On Broadway Gallery member artist, Paul Mathenia, will premier two of his paintings at the West Coast Art & Frame Show January 30 through February 1, 2012 at the Mirage Resort in Las Vegas, Nevada. Mathenia will be in Las Vegas for the unveiling of his new work, but prior to leaving on his trip he will conduct a free painting demonstration at Art On Broadway Gallery on Saturday, January 21, beginning at 1:30 p.m. He is one of twenty member artists at the gallery and currently has four original watercolors on exhibit there.

Join music director Travis Hatton 30 minutes before each performance for a special pre-concert presentation of insights into the performance, as part of the new Prelude Conversation series.
