What is Portland Open Studios?

The annual Portland Open Studios tour is a unique opportunity for you to open your studio to the public and educate visitors about your creative methods and materials, inspiration and enjoyment. As a member, you will meet other artists, have access to quality publicity and dialogue, and sell your work.

Open to all visual media, excluding film. Artists are chosen by a jury of three art professionals.

The participation fee is \$150 plus 8 hours of volunteer service. Participants may opt out of volunteering for an additional \$175. Applicant submissions before March 8 receive a discounted jury fee of \$25. After March 8, the jury fee is \$35.

Artists are required to open their studio and demonstrate their working methods on both weekends.

Invitation for artists to exhibit work at the Doll Gardner Gallery for a special exhibition "The World of Women," April 2012.

SHOW INFORMATION:

This show, scheduled to run through the month of April, invites artists involved in creating wall artwork that celebrates women and the feminine to submit jpegs of work for jurying. All work does not need to be original (giclees accepted), however all work needs to be available for sale in the show. Work must be framed (or in the case of canvases, must have painted edges) and must have wires attached that are suitable for the weight of the piece. In addition, the gallery encourages artists to bring shrink

wrapped unframed work, which is kept as back stock and is displayed in a print bin on Sundays. All work is insured once hung.

JURYING:

To jury in to the show please submit 3 jpegs of work that will be for sale in the show with your name and the title of the piece as the file name. Subject matter can cover the gamut from intense to delightful. Work that honors life, nature, or the human spirit has been well received.
