Beaverton International Celebration – Saturday, June 28!

Temporary Sculpture Program – Call to Artists – DEADLINE MONDAY!

The Beaverton Arts Commission (BAC) seeks to place sculpture in prominent outdoor locations to enliven civic spaces with work of high artistic quality. This opportunity is open to artists from Oregon, Washington and Idaho.

Two sculptures will be selected with a rental fee of \$3000 paid per sculpture with a rental period lasting two years (Sept. 2012-Sept. 2014.) Selected sculptures will be placed at Lombard Plaza and Progress Lake. The artist will be responsible for transportation, installation and de-installation of the work, including providing a base that will be attached to concrete. The City of Beaverton will maintain the work, create publicity materials and feature the work on the Beaverton Arts Commission website.

30th Annual Visual Arts Showcase - Call to Artists

Visual artists in Oregon are invited to submit their work to the Beaverton Arts Commission's 30th Annual Visual Arts Showcase to be held November 3-11, 2012, in the Beaverton City Library (12375 SW 5th Street in Beaverton.)

Showcase artists will be honored at an invite-only Preview on Saturday, November 3 at 6:00 PM, and an opening night gala immediately following from 7:00-9:00 PM. Prizes will be awarded including seven, \$100, first place awards and a \$500, "Best of Show" prize.

- Notification of acceptance or non-acceptance will occur the week of September 3, 2012
- Accepted artwork must be delivered to Beaverton City Library on Wednesday, October 24, from 4:00-7:00 PM. Late work will not be accepted.
- Artwork must be picked up at the Beaverton City Library on Sunday, November 11, from 5:00-7:00 PM
