There are an infinite number of ways one can bind, stitch, fold, twist or compress cloth for shibori and each way results in very different textures and patterns. Barbara Setsu Pickett and her son Michael Pickett formed Mihara Shibori Studio in 2005. The duo are experts in making highly textured silk scarves using traditional Japanese shibori techniques. The artists will be instructing a 2 day OCAC workshop May 25 - 26 that will include an in-depth exploration of shibori.
