**BAC Accepting Scholarship Self-Nominations for BAC Fine/Performing Art Graduating Seniors - [Deadline April 21!](#)**

The Beaverton Arts Commission is now accepting applications for the Annual Art Student Scholarship Program for high school seniors. The deadline to apply is Monday, April 21.

To qualify, students must currently be in their senior year of high school. The following scholarships will be awarded:

- \$1,000 for Outstanding Visual Art High School Senior –includes traditional media, design and moving image.
- \$1,000 for Outstanding Performance Art High School Senior –includes music, dance, singing, and drama. Tech crew members can also apply.
