Calling Musicians and Visual Artists - Metro Perc's New "Thursday Gallery Night" and "Friday Night Live" Events

Thursday Gallery Night:

- 6-8PM (thoughts on this?) every Thursday in June, July and August
- Artists should plan on bringing a minimum of 10 art pieces (2D or small-scale 3D)
- Artists are responsible for hanging/displaying their own work
- Must be appropriate for families (no nudes or overt political/religious themes)
- Metro Perc will have a simple wall hanging system available (wall hooks) and artist are encouraged to bring in their own easels/pedestals if they like
- Art will remain up for 2 weeks and artists must attend both Thursday Gallery Night events that fall within their display period
- Metro Perc will retain a 20% commission of the sale price
- Student artwork welcome!

Friday Night Live:

- 6-8PM (thoughts on this?) every Friday in June, July and August
- Musicians will need to provide their own equipment

- No stipend available but musicians can certainly sell CD's or other products
- Music should fit the coffee shop environment (no rock, rap or heavy metal bands)
- Student musicians welcome!
