UPDATE: Highland Park Middle School East Hill Improvement Project– Reggie Frumkin

Phase I: is complete (restored trail in SE corner of property on 7/9) weeding, landscape logs, gravel \$181 (\$6 buckets, \$23 rebar, \$21 landscaping timbers, \$33 truck rental, \$51 gravel 1.5 cubic feet, \$45 refreshments) 45 volunteer hours - \$1,038.14, \$312 in kind donations – Beaverton School District owns
Phase II: Tree planting/shrub planting – 100 plants, 18 conifers, 21 deciduous trees/shrubs, machinery, sewer easements, athletic fields could be set-backs. Clean water services project – help will help mulch 11/9 Wednesday (students)- would like to add a plaque \$100/\$200
