Mayor Doyle was honored for his work building connections throughout the community and championing addressing affordable housing solutions for seniors and low-income residents.

"It means so much to us to honor Mayor Doyle who is such a champion for children, elders and the Beaverton community," said Dr. Derenda Schubert, Executive Director of Bridge Meadows. "His dedication makes him a true advocate, and we are so fortunate to have him as a partner."

Bridge Meadows is a unique, intergenerational housing community that provides homes for adoptive families of youth formerly in foster care and older adults who help the younger families. Located in the Central Beaverton neighborhood on the corner of SW Allen Blvd and SW Menlo Drive, the community opened in August 2017.
