Welcome and Introductions, NAC Chair Mike Alner

Tualatin Valley Fire and Rescue Report, Station 66 Staff

- Wilsonville Community Carnival on May 18
- Sponsored Beaverton half marathon/5K – first aid and hydration center
 - Out of 540 participants, only 1 was transferred to the hospital
- 4 hours of training for every station in preparation for the summer
- 13 firefighters and 8 paramedics will be coming on when the current class graduates
- Annual station inspection completed by battalion chief, passed with an A rating
- 118 code 3 calls since last NAC meeting
 - 2017 review: 6 fire stations to city of Beaverton, our station takes 17% of the calls
 - 9812 EMS calls, 956 fire calls (184 were vegetation fires)
 - Peak time is around 1pm
 - 24% increase in calls from 2013 to 2017
 - 49,000 calls as a fire district
- Summer safety warnings provided
- Invited fire station to join us at the movie night

Tualatin Hills Park and Recreation Department Report, Steve Gulgren

- Cedar Park tennis courts were resurfaced in 2009; it will likely be awhile before it will be redone since they generally have a 20-year lifetime
- July 4 Summer Concert with the American Legion Post
- Several other summer concerts this summer
- Summerset and Raleigh outdoor pools opening June 25
- Splash pad at Conestoga Rec is open

- ADA transition plan bringing changes to Elsie Stuhr and Harman Swim Center (first phase is focused on accessibility from parking lot to building)
- Updating parks functional plan- doing them every 3-5 years instead of long-term 20-year plans
