The event is organized by Lascala Food Hall in partnerships with the City of Beaverton, German International School, Tualatin Hills Park & Recreation District, Central Beaverton Neighborhood and Beaverton Downtown Association.

Parts of Lombard Avenue and 1st Street will be blocked off for this free community event that will include live music and performances, a beer tent, games, craft booths, many children’s activities and unique vendor stalls. German inspired food and imported German beer and wine will be available.

The event benefits Family Promise of Beaverton with 10 percent of net proceeds from specified vendors being provided to this local non-profit that provides temporary shelter, food, services and case management for homeless families with children.
