BEAVERTON CITY LIBRARY HOSTS “MAKE EVERY DAY A READING DAY” WORKSHOP SERIES

BEAVERTON, Ore. – This fall, Beaverton City Library hosts the workshop series “Make Every Day a Reading Day.” Taking place at the Murray Scholls branch in October and at the main library in November, the workshops will teach parents and caregivers the skills children need to build a strong foundation for future school readiness and learning to read.

Each workshop will focus on a different readiness practice—talking, singing, reading, writing, playing, math and science—and will include stories, songs, activities and take-home tips. While the workshops are adult-focused, they are designed to be fun for kids. Children will receive one free book per workshop.
