Mark Hokkanen THPRD:

- Mobile recreation programs will begin to restart at specific elementary schools
- All facilities closed indefinitely until county risk levels lower to the “orange category”
- Raleigh Hills outside pool open
- Park district currently open virtually
- Volunteer opportunities- Garden Clean up and removal of invasive species
- Car Bingo at Stir center off Hall street 10 am on Monday
- Free fitness in the park has restarted that will continue through mid-March
- Outdoor fitness programs open for teens

Franziska Rose City Of Beaverton:

- Mayor Lacey Beaty begins her first term as Mayor after serving on the City Council since 2015. Her vacated City Council position will be filled at the council’s direction.
- Councilor Nadia Hasan and Councilor Allison Tivnon join as new council members filling an established seat and an expanded position as part of the new city charter. Nadia Hasan is the first to hold City Council Position 6.
- Councilor Mark Fagin, Councilor Laura Mitchel, and Councilor Marc San Soucie rejoin the council as re-elected and existing council members.

- The Beaverton City Council has appointed Kurt Wilson as the city’s first Interim City Manager. The announcement marks a milestone in the City Charter of 2021 implementation. The new charter became operational on January 1.
- The Interim City Manager is an important position that will help the city transition to a council-manager form of government and support the hiring of a long-term City Manager.
- Kurt has nearly 30 years of experience with the local government holding both elected and hired positions.
- Most recently, he served as the City Manager of the City of Stockton in California.
- The recruitment for a long-term City Manager is expected to begin in spring and will include opportunities for further staff and community engagement.
