DECLARATIONS

1. The Beaverton Municipal Court is located in the Griffith Building at 4755 SW Griffith Drive, Beaverton, Washington County, Oregon.
2. The Presiding Judge for the Beaverton Municipal Court is Judge John T. Mercer.
3. The Beaverton Municipal Court consists of two courtrooms, various staff offices, judges' chambers, jury room(s), and utilizes the hallway in the north end of the building and the entry area/foyer in the building.
4. This order is to implement ORS 166.370(2)(a)(C) regarding firearms in the local court facility that is The Beaverton Municipal Courts' space in the Griffith Building.

FINDINGS

1. The Beaverton Municipal Court(s) is located on the first and second floors of the Griffith Building, located at 4755 SW Griffith Drive, Beaverton, Washington County, Oregon.
2. The Beaverton Municipal Court is a local court facility.
3. The space and rooms for court use, and the hours of operation are as follows:
 - a. The entrance and lobby/foyer are in its entirety from the east entrance into the building;
 - b. The entire hallway from the lobby to the north on the first floor;
 - c. Courtrooms A and B, and judges' chambers;
 - d. All staff offices off the north hallway, including the court office off the north hallway for attorneys/ADES evaluator use, and the main staff office area behind the front counter windows;
 - e. Staff offices on the south end of the building on the first floor for the Court Administrator and the Court Technology staff.
 - f. The Jury Deliberation Room and the Court Conference Room, also in the south end of the first floor.
 - g. The B-SOBR Case Manager's Office on the second floor.
 - h. The hours of operation for the court are 7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. on Monday and Friday; 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday; and hours for jury trial

activity on Thursday and Friday may extend indefinitely beyond the 7:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. respectively.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED, effective the date signed below, in the local court facility described above and incorporated by this reference, all firearms are prohibited in the area described where the court conducts business during the hours listed. The prohibition applies to all firearms, loaded or unloaded as prescribed in ORS 166.370.
