


City of Beaverton Boards & Commissions Quick Guide



BEAVERTON ARTS COMMISSION (BAC) – Celebrates our diverse community through art by advocating for the arts, supporting city arts events, and advising staff and City Council on arts-related issues.

Meetings: 2nd Wednesday of the month | 6:30 p.m. | Beaverton City Hall

BEAVERTON COMMITTEE FOR COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT (BCCI) –

Provides an opportunity for community members to exchange ideas and information with city government, to monitor and evaluate public involvement programs, and to have a voice in the land use planning process as per Senate Bill 100.

Meetings: 4th Monday of the month | 6:30 p.m. | Beaverton City Hall

BEAVERTON COMMITTEE ON AGING (BCOA) – Examines issues and concerns of the aging population in Beaverton and offers representation, information and education regarding these issues.

Meetings: 2nd Tuesday of the month | 3:00 p.m. | Beaverton City Hall

BEAVERTON URBAN REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (BURA) BOARD –

Responsible for developing and implementing the voter approved Central Beaverton Urban Renewal Plan.

Meetings: monthly on a Tuesday* | 6:30 p.m. | Beaverton City Hall

BEAVERTON URBAN REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (BURA) BUDGET COMMITTEE –

Responsible for approving the budget for the BURA Board in May, concurrent with the City of Beaverton budget cycle.

Meetings: held during budget process each May* | Beaverton City Hall

BICYCLE ADVISORY COMMITTEE – Promotes bicycle use in and around Beaverton. Provides review, as needed, on significant public and private plans and development projects that may impact bicycle and pedestrian circulation, access and general use. Recommends priorities in alignment with the Active Transportation Plan and Community Vision Plan.

Meetings: 2nd Thursday of the month | 6:30 p.m. | Beaverton City Hall

BUDGET COMMITTEE – Approves the City's proposed budget and submits it to the City Council for review and final adoption.

Meetings: held yearly during May and November* | Beaverton City Hall

DIVERSITY ADVISORY BOARD (DAB) – Advises on diversity, equity, and inclusion strategies that improve outcomes for marginalized communities. Assists the City in strengthening relationships with historically underrepresented communities, especially communities of color, immigrants, and refugees.

Meetings: 2nd Monday of the month | 6:30 p.m. | Beaverton City Hall

HUMAN RIGHTS ADVISORY COMMISSION (HRAC) – Promotes intergroup relations by enlisting the cooperation of various racial, religious, and nationality groups, business, community, labor and governmental organizations, educational and other groups. Examines sources of tension, practices of discrimination and acts of prejudice by employees of the City.
Meetings: 1st Wednesday of the month | 6:30 p.m. | Beaverton Library - main

LIBRARY ADVISORY BOARD – The Board serves in an advisory capacity and approves expenditures from the Library Trust fund.
Meetings: 2nd Wednesday of the month | 6:00 p.m. | Beaverton Library - main

PLANNING COMMISSION – Reviews and recommends changes to the City's comprehensive plan, zoning ordinances, and other long-range planning and development policies and ordinances. Considers issues involving subdivisions, annexations, capital improvements, transportation and circulation.
Meetings: each Wednesday | 6:30 p.m. | Beaverton City Hall

SOCIAL SERVICES FUNDING COMMITTEE (SSFC) – Reviews annual social service grant applications and makes funding recommendations to City Council.
*Meetings: held during the grant application process each year**

TRAFFIC COMMISSION – Advises City Council on traffic safety issues, assists in promulgating standards and policies related to neighborhood traffic management, and reviews and comments upon changes to traffic patterns and programs.
Meetings: 1st Thursday of the month | 7:00 p.m. | Beaverton City Hall

URBAN RENEWAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE (URAC) – Provides advice and recommendations to BURA. URAC advises on refining the projects within the geographic boundaries of the Central Beaverton Urban Renewal Plan, the priority of projects, and recommendations to encourage public involvement in plan development.
Meetings: 1st Monday of the month | 7:00 p.m. | Beaverton City Hall

VISIONING ADVISORY COMMITTEE (VAC) – Serves to promote the City's community-based visioning process; encourages continued community involvement in visioning; establishes and updates the City Visioning Plan; and provides regular updates regarding the visioning process.
Meetings: 1st Wednesday of the month | 6:30 p.m. | Beaverton City Hall
