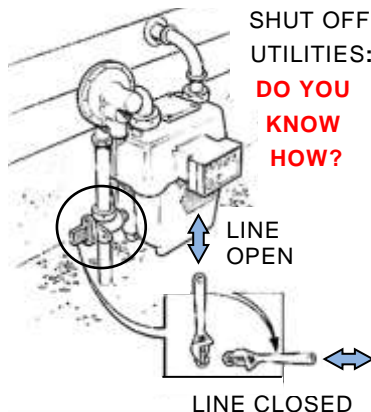




Calling All Beaverton Hispanic Community Members!

- September 20 – Module 1: Preparedness, Utility Shut-off, and Fire Extinguishers
- September 27 – Module 2: First Aid and CPR/AED with certification
- October 4– Module 3: Triage and Disaster First Aid
- October 11 – Module 4: Light Search and Rescue Part 1, and Disaster Psychology
- October 18 – Module 5: Light Search and Rescue Part 2, and Team Organization
